Gibbon's Time Trial – Inglewood

Another Gibbons Time Trial and just another perfect sunny day in Inglewood of course. Other than a bit of a headwind for a couple of laps, the conditions were perfect for racing. The winner on the day though was Theresa's soup. I am not one to tell stories, but I hear some people only came out for the soup; can't believe that one can you Ivor!

A warm welcome to Laura and Thomas Kehely, their Egmont shirts were only outshone by their walking. Both did 1.25K today, Laura in 7m25s and Thomas at 7 years old did 11m48s. Thomas certainly showed us what race walking style is all about. Completing our junior section was Hannah who did her 5K in a smart 36m38s.

With Brian judging and others overseas, Sandra was first away in today's race (first and last time considering her result). Next up were Anne, Gaylene followed by Nana (with the tanned legs from Rarotonga) and Neil (without the tanned legs). I never saw Sandra and Anne again until after I finished – so guess what happens to your handicap next time! I got into a decent pace after 1 lap and gradually closed on Dennis in front of me. Other than Gaylene who was crook and just going for a walk I really didn't see anybody else for several laps (other than Harry, Mike and Eric who started over a lap in arrears).

With 2 laps to go, Wacky roared past me and shot off into the distance. I had closed to within 30 seconds of Dennis, fairly early in the race, but we just matched each other stride for 5 strides. Meanwhile up front Anne had passed Sandra, but Sandra then took the lead again. When the bell went I could see Neil and Helen up ahead, but the bell then started dinging in quick succession behind me (at this point you don't bother to look behind). Sure enough with 500 metres to go I had Eric, steam engine Mike and then Rachel pass me in quick succession. One could also feel the next chasers not very far behind. At the end Sandra hung onto her lead with a fast finishing Wacky just 5 seconds behind and then just 7 more seconds back to Anne. The Inglewood connection wins again! The next places were very close with Dennis; Eric; Mike; Neil; Helen and me finishing within the space of about 30 seconds. Faster male was Eric in a very quick 55m24s and fastest female was Rachel in 58m42s.
