Leaving New Plymouth in the pouring rain, I decided full wet weather gear was in order. Arrived in Inglewood with the sun shining and had to borrow Anne's sunglasses; I don't think purple is my colour.

Another good turnout today with 20 walkers and seven helpers. Eric brought his tent along so our timekeepers didn't get wet. Due to the nature of the course the first few walkers off the start had no one in sight in those early laps. The first indication there was a race in progress was after 15mins when Serena & Ross came into view, shoulder to shoulder and bearing down on a bright pink Carol.

Michelle had caught and passed MaryAnne whilst Sherryn was about 100m in front of Tony. Carol had removed her coat but it didn't make her any lighter as she tied it around her waist and now Denis was 50m ahead of her with Gaylene about 50m further back. Serena had clawed back the gap and was now only 3m behind Ross.

Gaylene passed a heavily strapped Sue who had a fall the previous weekend in Wellington. It was all on for the last half a lap as Rachel passed Serena and closed in on Ross who had really dug it in to open the biggest gap over Serena to date. Alan had caught and passed Sherryn and was only 20m behind Ross but was himself being passed by Peter who wasn't all that far behind Eric now. It must have been hard on the timekeepers checking them in as they were all looking to finish together. How it all panned out in the end you'll have to wait until Serena publishes the results.

The weather Gods must have been in a good mood today because they held off the rain until everyone had finished before starting to rain.

Personally, I thought there was some good walking out there and it is heartening to see a number making a real effort to walk legally. Seeing that makes standing in a hot sun in waterproofs all worthwhile. So, keep up the good work.
